Publication of Articles for OPHTA

General Information

Target group for ophta articles: Swiss Ophthalmologists and orthoptists.

Manuscripts that have been published elsewhere are not eligible.

Topics should cover the interests and needs of practicing ophthalmologists.

Authors must certify they have writen the article themselves and independently of industry interests.

There is no classical peer-review, but editorial board members of the relevant subspecialty will be asked for an assessment.

Preferred languages: German or French

Forum articles (Letters to the Editors, etc.): German, or French, or Italian

Original articles German or French or English

Dates, timelines: LINK

File formats, manuscript preparation

_ Text files: *.doc, *.docx, *.rtf, *.txt

_ Image files (high resolution, 300dpi): *.JPG, *.tif, *.CR3, for graphs also *.ppt

_ Submit image files separately, do **not** include images in the Word file; provide legends within the manuscript, provide list of images / tables plus legends in the text file

_ Clinical images: publication consent of patients has to be obtained. General consent for the use in scientific work is sufficient in case of anonymized data. Explicit consent has to be obtained if personal traits are visible (non-anonymizable), consent form [LINK]. This is the author's responsibility, please save the consent in an electronic format.

_ Images of persons (authors, awardees, etc.): The written consent of all identifiably persons must be provided in advance of publication.

_ Copyright has to be clarified by the author. For work of other authors, the ophta author has to obtain permission by the copyright holder. Please send Rights Link permission number and proof of permission. If contacted early enough, the ophta editorial team will assist and/or pay the fees.

_ References: Vancouver format, examples [LINK]

_ Adress of **corresponding author**, disclosure of Conflicts of Interest is mandatory, author's portrait at author's discretion.

Submission category / text length

Practice / Ophthalmosurgery / Survey

2-3 pages: max. 12000 characters (spaces included) + references; less if images or tables are included. For longer articles, please contact the desk editor in acvance.

Forum

1 page, 4500 characters

Quick Facts

1 page, 1 – 3 images, max. 3 references, 1000 characters

Guest Editorial

1 page, 4500 characters

½ page, 2200 characters

News of the Industry

1 page = 4500 characters, or 2200 characters German + 2200 characters French

Contact address of the responsible firm

Other (hommage, obituary, « Focus »): Please contact the editorial team in advance.

Titles, headlines

Maximum headline length: 60 characters (spaces included) If not sufficient: Top line, 45 characters (spaces included)

2 headline categories within the text. It is not mandatory to use a fixed scheme (such as background, purpose, materials and methods, results, discussion, conclusion) but the manuscript must follow a logical line. Upon publication of an article, all rights are held by the publishers, including the rights to reproduce all or part of any publication. For images, the copyright will remain with the author, please clarify in advance. Clinical or experimental studies involving persons must be reviewed and approved by the relevant ethics committee. Animal ex-periments require that applicable standards of applicable animal protection laws have been followed.

Disclosure of financial interests

- Support from a for-profit company or competing company
- Personal investment in a company or competing company (other than through a mutual or retirement fund)
- Employment by a company or competing company with business interest in the topic
- Being a Consultant of a company or competing company with business interest in the topic
- Inventor/Developer of the topic or a competing topic
- Travel Reimbursement, gifts or honoraria of > 2000 EUR in the last twelve months by a company or competing company involved

Each co-author is aware of the commercial relationships policy and has approved the final version of the manuscript. Approval of each co-author has to be obtained prior to submission.

Copyright

With the acceptance of a manuscript, the publisher acquires the exploitation rights for the duration of the statutory term of protection.

Exceptions are agreed upon in writing with the author(s), usually for image data. Reprinting, translations, duplications, microfilming, storage and processing in electronic electronic systems - also in extracts - are only permitted with the written consent of the publisher.
